This two-day festival is an immersive journey into Ireland's rich storytelling tradition, featuring an impressive lineup of 8 feature films, including critically acclaimed titles and innovative works by emerging talent. The festival shines a spotlight on the range of voices in the industry, including award winning documentaries, authored experimental film, and an Irish language feature film.
